The Jewish Festival of Sukkot (The Festival of Booths) is an 8-day holiday that commemorates the 40 years the Israelites wandered in the desert. Temporary structures, or "booths' are built during this time and used for meals and friendly gatherings.

The Mid-Autumn Festival, also known as the "Moon Festival," is the second-largest holiday on the Chinese calendar (after the Lunar New Year). People celebrate with outdoor gatherings in the moonlight with family and friends, and prayers for a good life.
