THE 14TH STREET Y AND SIROVICH CENTER FOR BALANCED LIVING (14Y/SIROVICH)

The 14th Street Y is a Jewish community center located in Downtown Manhattan. Each year, tens of thousands of New Yorkers of all ages, races, and ethnicities come to 14Y as members, visitors, or partners to experience our high quality and varied programs centered around arts and culture, early childhood education, afterschool, summer camps, fitness and aquatics, Jewish life, and older adult services.

At 14Y, we offer a wide array of dynamic programs that honor the multi-faceted perspectives of our downtown community. As a convening space for arts and ideas, we have a long history of facilitating thoughtful and innovative conversations that engage our audiences. Our recently expanded adult programming includes classes, clubs, and workshops that fill a critically untapped need for a gathering space; activities like pickleball, knitting club, and canasta make people want to connect with one another.

We are proud to be a multicultural, open-tent community that reflects the vibrancy of NYC. We celebrate Jewish values and culture in the ways that we approach our programming and how we show up in the world.



MEET LAURIANNE AND RIMONA

Laurianne is an octogenarian member of 14Y's Sirovich Center for Balanced Living. Rimona is an elementary school aged student in 14Y's afterschool program. Once a week, they come together to participate in 14Y's intergenerational tap dance class, building bridges across generations.

CENTER FOR RECOVERY AND WELLNESS (CRW)

At Educational Alliance's Center for Recovery and Wellness (CRW), we are committed to serving whole individuals, whole families, and whole communities. Our dedicated staff take a holistic, strengths-based approach to recovery and wellness that responds to the distinct needs of each individual. Our programs include residential and outpatient addiction treatment, recovery services, prevention education, and community programming such as our free Community Food Program and employment and housing services. Currently, CRW is also working to combat the fentanyl crisis by reaching at-risk individuals and offering innovative drug treatment programs that incorporate music, art, and wellness into the recovery process.

We believe integrated, inclusive approaches that connect individuals with their families and communities lead to more effective interventions and long-term success. We offer culturally competent, evidence-based programs and services that strengthen individuals and communities, enhance resiliency, and foster lasting recovery.



MEET CHEF PETE

As the cook at our Center for Recovery and Wellness, Chef Pete oversees one of the most meaningful vocational education programs on offer: the opportunity to work in our kitchen and earn a food handler's certificate – which prepares clients to work in a professional kitchen.

An important part of rehabilitation is finding purpose. The skills or employment that individuals develop while with us enable them to provide for themselves and their families when they leave treatment, a powerful incentive to maintain sobriety long-term.

COMMUNITY SCHOOLS AND YOUTH DEVELOPMENT (CSYD)

Educational Alliance's Community Schools & Youth Development (CSYD) department plays an integral role in delivering high-quality youth programming throughout the Lower East Side with services embedded in the school day, afterschool programs, and summer enrichment opportunities.

Every year, our afterschool enrichment program serves over a thousand students from kindergarten to eighth grade. Both during the school year and summer (through our Summer Rising program), we help children from under-resourced schools discover their own potential through tutoring, science enrichment, counseling, performing arts, sports, and more. Our robust team of social workers ensures that social-emotional learning concepts are present in all aspects of our work and that participants have access to individualized care and attention when needed. Our Community School Directors play a critical role in bringing a wealth of resources and opportunities directly to families, and our Program Directors rely on local talent to create a student-centered, experiential learning environment where students realize that the sky is their only limit.

We work to enrich our students' lives in partnership with PS 64, PS 142, PS/MS 140, TSMS, and PS/MS 188, the NYC Department of Youth & Community Development (DYCD), NYC Office of Community Schools (OCS), New York Cares (NYCares), The Boys and Girls Clubs of America (BGCA), and of course, our incredible local school communities.



MEET MS. ATONIA

She has been working as a teaching artist with our Community Schools afterschool program for the last 15 years.

At our afterschool programs, kids can grow into the people they are meant to be. They are where kids can grow in some of the most profound ways: interpersonal relationships, intellectual exploration, self-assurance, and more.

Ms. Atonia's students start with small dance performances and work their way up to full scale productions of popular musicals. Thanks to Ms. Atonia, thousands of children have learned the joy of theater and, in the process, have developed tenacity and poise, as well as their capacity for artistic collaboration.


